Somewhere between homework and screens, our children are quietly drifting from where they come from. They can name every superhero, but not why we light lamps on Diwali. They know a hundred YouTube facts, but not that India gave the world the number zero. It isn't their fault, no one ever made India feel like *theirs*.

What your child gets

This isn't a culture class. In six live, discussion-filled Sundays, your child receives three things that stay for life:



Pride in their roots

India stops being a vague idea and becomes theirs, a child who stands a little taller about where they come from.



The confidence to speak

Every session is discussion-led, so a quiet child learns to share an opinion, defend a view, and hold a room.



A published anthology

Your child writes their own India story, published in a real anthology on Amazon under their name, for most, their first time in print.



Wonder & real thinking

The astonishing true facts most adults never learned, and the habit of questioning, not just accepting.

The moment you'll never forget: one evening, a few weeks in, your child looks up from dinner and asks, **"Did you know India has three names? Do you know why we really light diyas?"**, and they know something you didn't. Roots doesn't just teach your child about India. **They come home and teach it to you.**

Who it's for

Ages 8–13, open to all, for every family. We celebrate India's heritage and wonder; we never teach religion as faith. No prior knowledge is needed, we tell all the stories from the very beginning. One warm group of just 10 children, so every child is seen and heard.

WHAT'S INSIDE

The six-Sunday journey

Every session is do-and-discuss, never a lecture. Your child meets a great part of India, joins a real discussion, and grows their own story a little more each week.

SESSION 1

The Land & its Wonders

India, Bharat, Hindustan, why three names, and where each came from. The states, the dazzling diversity, and the marvels India gave the world: zero, Ayurveda, yoga, and wonders you can one day visit.

Discussion: "Tell us about your state, what makes it special?"

SESSION 2

The Ramayana

The great adventure, told big, exile, Hanuman's leap, the bridge, the return, and the astonishing fact that it is told across half of Asia.

Discussion: hot-seat a character; "was every choice right?"

SESSION 3

The Mahabharata

The longest poem ever written, and its very human questions about choices, family and fairness.

Discussion: "What would you have done?"

SESSION 4

India's Clever Tales

The Panchatantra and Jataka fables, where wit and kindness beat brute strength. Each child retells a fable in their own way.

Discussion: "What's the real lesson?"

SESSION 5

Celebrations & Songs

The great festivals as celebrations of life, light, harvest, colour, new beginnings, and the hidden reasons behind them. Then India's music: the national anthem, Lata the Nightingale, and Bollywood.

Discussion: "Share your family's favourite festival."

SESSION 6

Tell Your Own India Story

Your child finishes, reads aloud and publishes their own India story, a retelling or their own "My India" piece, in the anthology, with a live book launch for the family.

The celebration: read-aloud, warm peer feedback, and the book launch.

HOW IT WORKS

The way we teach it

One story, everyone included

Every child hears the same great story and the same jaw-dropping fact, then writes at their own level. That's how a group of 8-to-13-year-olds learns together beautifully, the youngest write a few vivid lines, the oldest craft a fuller piece, and the anthology holds them all.

Discussion, not lecture

Kids share, gently debate, and step into characters every session. A quiet child finds their voice; every age has something to say. This is where the speaking confidence quietly grows.

How your child becomes a published author

They don't face a blank page. Across the six weeks their own India story grows one small step at a time, until there's nothing left to do but finish it. It's then published in a real anthology on Amazon, under their name, and read aloud at a live book launch the family attends.

A gateway to more

The confidence and the love of stories your child builds here open the door to our specialist studios, Speaker's (public speaking), Debate, and Young Author, for the child who catches the spark.

Frequently asked

What will my child actually learn?

The wonder of India, its stories, festivals, music and marvels, and the values and thinking inside them. Along the way they get comfortable speaking, sharing opinions and writing, and they finish with their own published story.

Is it religious?

No. It's about India's heritage and wonder, stories, festivals, music, monuments, open to all, for every family. We celebrate the culture; we don't teach religion as faith.

My child doesn't know any of these stories.

Perfect. We'll tell all the stories, from the very beginning. No prior knowledge is needed.

Does it teach public speaking or debate?

It builds the confidence, every session is discussion-led, so your child gets comfortable speaking up and sharing a view. For the full craft of public speaking or debate, our Speaker's and Debate studios go deep; Roots is the gateway.

How do you teach an 8-year-old and a 13-year-old together?

Shared stories, age-appropriate writing. Everyone enjoys the same tale and facts, then writes at their own level, so no one is bored and no one is lost. The small group of 10 lets us give each child individual attention.

Is my child really published?

Yes, their India story is published in a real anthology on Amazon, under their name, with a live book launch for the family. You order copies from Amazon at cover price.

When and how does it run?

6 live online sessions, Sundays 11:00 AM to 12:00 noon IST, one small group, from 19 July 2026.

What if I need to cancel?

7 or more days before the first session: full refund, or a free transfer to a later batch. 2–7 days before: 50%, or a free transfer. Within 48 hours of the first session, or once it has started: non-refundable.
