That is exactly what Roots Studio does. It gives your child India back, not as a lecture, but as the most wonderful story they've ever been let into.

This is not a school-style culture class. In six live, discussion-filled sessions, your child travels the wonder of Bharat, discovers things even most adults don't know, learns to speak up and think for themselves, and writes their very own India story, **published in a real anthology, with their name on it.** They come away with three real things: pride in their roots, more confidence, and a book they actually wrote.

One evening, a few weeks in, your child will look up from dinner and say, *"Did you know India has three names? Do you know why we really light diyas?"*, and they'll know something you didn't. That's the magic of Roots: your child doesn't just learn about India, **they come home and teach it to you.** And at the end, they hand you a book with their name on the cover.

The six-session journey

#	SESSION	WHERE YOUR CHILD GOES
1	The Land & its Wonders	India, Bharat, Hindustan, why three names; the states; the marvels India gave the world (zero, Ayurveda, yoga)
2	The Ramayana	The great adventure, told big, a story shared by half of Asia
3	The Mahabharata	The longest poem ever written, and its very human questions
4	India's Clever Tales	The fables where wit and kindness beat brute strength

5	Celebrations & Songs	Festivals as celebrations of life (and their hidden reasons) + India's music: the anthem, Lata the Nightingale, Bollywood
6	Tell Your Own India Story	Your child finishes, reads aloud, and publishes their story → the anthology + a live book launch

Every session is do-and-discuss, never a lecture. Shared stories with age-appropriate writing, so it works beautifully across ages 8–13.

Questions parents ask

What will my child actually learn? The wonder of India, its stories, festivals, music and marvels, and the values and thinking inside them. Along the way they get comfortable speaking, sharing opinions and writing, and they finish with their own published story.

Is it religious? No. It's about India's heritage and wonder, open to all, for every family. We celebrate the culture; we don't teach religion as faith.

My child doesn't know any of these stories. Perfect. We'll tell all the stories, from the very beginning. No prior knowledge is needed.

Is my child really published? Yes, their India story is published in a real anthology on Amazon, under their name, with a live book launch for the family.

What if I need to cancel? 7+ days before the first session: full refund or a free transfer. 2–7 days: 50% or a transfer. Within 48 hours or after it starts: non-refundable.
